Joyce E. Rose, 78, Goshen, died 5:35 p.m. Monday, Aug. 5, 2019 at Goshen Hospital. She was born July 23, 1941 in Elkhart to Clell & Viola (Roberts) Grissom. On Aug. 11, 1962 she married Thomas L. Rose.

Surviving are her husband, Thomas, son, Brock (Rose) Rose and granddaughter, Amanda Rose, all of Goshen.

Preceding her in death are her parents and an infant brother.

Joyce was a 1959 graduate of Elkhart High School and of the Elkhart School of Radiology. She worked as an x-ray technician in Goshen and Elkhart and retired in 1975. Joyce, along with her husband, Tom, authored two cookbooks, "Cooking Together with Tom & Joyce". They hosted cooking feature on FOX 28 morning show for 13 years and taught cooking classes throughout the Midwest. Joyce was a member of St. Mary of the Annunciation Catholic Church, Bristol, Daughters of the Revolution (DAR) and Delta Tau Delta Sorority.

I will treasure this rare photo from long ago but even more will I treasure my memories of Joyce herself.
